THE AWARD WINNER MUST ATTEND THE AFA ANNUAL MEETING (MARCH, 2-3, 2016) FOR THE DURATION AND ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO PRESENT ANY RESEARCH RESULTS.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must be currently enrolled in a graduate degree program in a field related to fisheries science at an educational institution that is accredited and in Alabama.
2. Must be in current good academic standing.
3. Must have a research proposal that is approved by graduate advisor.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

**THE FOLLOWING IS DUE TO THE AFA SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE BY:**

**February 1, 2016**

1. A copy of transcripts of undergraduate and graduate work completed to date
2. A letter from the student's major professor recommending the student for the scholarship, indicating that the student is currently enrolled and in good standing, and has had their research proposal approved by their graduate advisor
3. A copy of the research proposal or an executive summary/abstract of the proposal (limited to 1000 words)
4. One letter of recommendation (from someone other than the major professor)
